Dallas County Conducts Ground Spraying Due to Positive Mosquito Trap

Lancaster, TX – A positive West Nile Virus mosquito trap location in the city was confirmed by Dallas County for the area surrounding Nancy Lane on Friday, October 25, 2013. The City of Lancaster has coordinated with Dallas County Health and Human Services to conduct ground spraying for the area surrounding the above mentioned location in the evening of Tuesday, October 29, 2013. Ground spraying will be conducted with weather permitting. The County will be focused on sites near the identified site where the positive mosquito trap was located.

Although the pesticide is approved by the Environmental Protection Agency, residents are advised to take the following precautions: Minimize exposure, remain indoors during the hours while spraying is in progress. Close windows and keep pets inside. If skin or clothes are exposed, wash them with soap and water. Rinse homegrown fruits and vegetables as a precaution. Cover small ornamental fish ponds and keep outdoor pets covered. The chemical breaks down quickly in sunlight and water, so no special precautions are suggested for outdoor swimming pools.

City of Lancaster residents are provided free mosquito dunks at 700 E. Main Street and 211 N. Henry Street while supplies last. This product assists in mosquito control by killing mosquito larvae when applied to water sources. Free mosquito repellent spray is also available.
