News You Can Use for July 4th!

Lancaster, TX – With the 4th of July Holiday quickly approaching, residents are advised to stay informed on what's happening around Lancaster.

- The City of Lancaster will be closed on Friday, July 4, 2014 in observance of the Independence Holiday.
- Trash and recycling pickup that is normally scheduled for Friday, July 4, 2014 will run on Saturday, July 5, 2014.
- The City of Lancaster will be hosting a July 4th Celebration at Lancaster Community Park on Friday, July 4, 2014. Between 6:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m. Lancaster residents should expect heavy traffic through North Dallas Avenue and North Jefferson Street between Wintergreen Road to Colonial Drive. The Lancaster Police Department will be closely patrolling this area.
- Those participating in the celebration are encouraged to utilize the parking areas at the Lancaster Recreation Center, Senior Life Center, Beverly D. Humphrey Tiger Stadium and Lancaster High School.
- Fireworks will be launched between 9:00 p.m. and 9:30 p.m. by licensed professionals and will be under the supervision of the Lancaster Fire Department.
- By City Ordinance, fireworks can only be used by licensed professionals. It is illegal to possess, sell or use fireworks within city limits. Violators could face fines up to \$2,000.
