Mosquito Ground Spraying has Been **CANCELLED Due to High Winds**

Lancaster, TX – A positive West Nile Virus mosquito trap location in the city was confirmed by Dallas County for the area's between McCormick and Pierson, on Wednesday, November 05, 2014. Due to high winds, ground spraying originally scheduled for Monday, November 10, 2014 has been **CANCELLED**. With the expected winter weather this week, rescheduling the ground spraying is not anticipated. When temperatures fall below freezing, adult mosquitoes die off.

Lancaster residents are provided free mosquito dunks at 700 E. Main Street and 211 N. Henry Street while supplies last. This product assists in mosquito control by killing mosquito larvae when applied to water sources. Free mosquito repellent spray is also available.
