**Lancaster**, **TX** – Lancaster has many historic landmarks dating back to the 1800's that still stand today. Preserving these landmarks is critical. The City of Lancaster is now accepting applications to apply to be on the Historic Landmark Preservation Committee. Do you have knowledge and experience in the history, art or architecture of Lancaster? If the answer is 'yes', then submit your application today!

The purpose of the Historic Landmark Preservation Committee is to become familiar with the buildings, land, areas, and districts within the city that may be eligible for designation as historic landmarks. The committee serves in an advisory capacity to the Planning and Zoning Commission. This Committee is composed of five members and one alternate. Members are appointed to a two-year staggered terms by the Planning and Zoning Commission and confirmed by the City Council. This Committee meets the fourth Tuesday of each month, 6:30 p.m. at the City Hall, Council Chambers, unless otherwise noted.
