The Great Texas Warrant Roundup Begins March 7th

Lancaster, TX – Beginning on Saturday, March 7, 2015 the City of Lancaster Municipal Court will be participating in the Annual Statewide Warrant Roundup Initiative with over 300 other participating jurisdictions in Texas. This program is designed to target thousands of outstanding defendants, encouraging them to dispose of their cases voluntarily, within the next two weeks, to avoid arrest. A number of notices were recently mailed statewide by participating entities.

The Municipal Court will be open from 8:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. to accommodate individuals with unresolved warrants. Prior to incarceration, defendants will be given full opportunity to pay their outstanding fines with Lancaster officials. Defendants may render payment with cash or credit card at the Municipal Court the morning of March 7, 2015.
