## **Lancaster City Council to Receive Disaster & Recovery Briefing Tonight**

**Lancaster, TX** – Tonight, Monday, April 16, 2012 at 7:00 p.m., City Manager Opal Mauldin Robertson will update City Council on disaster recovery operations in response to the April 3, 2012 tornado.

This meeting will include an audio/visual, seven-day timeline beginning Tuesday, April 3, 2012 when the city-wide warning sirens and CodeRed Weather Warnings were activated through the demobilization of the Emergency Operations Center (EOC) on Tuesday, April 10, 2012, one week after the tornado.

The presentation will also provide a recap of mutual aid organization responders and other activities including visits by Governor Rick Perry and other elected officials. The update will conclude with a broad look at next steps in the long-term recovery process for the community.
