## Fire Crews Respond to Two Fires

**Lancaster, TX** – In the early morning of Wednesday, December 12, 2012 the City of Lancaster and mutual aid agencies responded to two structural fires.

At 1:43 a.m. a fire was reported at the 2200 block of Daniieldale. Flammable fiberglass insulation fueled the fire generating large amounts of smoke and requiring mutual aid assistance from neighboring emergency response teams including Red Oak, Waxahachie, Ferris, Desoto, Glenn Heights, Hutchins, Ovilla, Dallas and DFW Airport.

A residential fire was reported by a passerby in the 900 block of Oak Bluff at 3:11 a.m. As a result of the unit response to the first fire, mutual aid from Dallas Fire Rescue responded. There were no injuries at either incident and both fires are still under investigation.
