## **Museum Offers Glimpse into Texas History**

**Lancaster, TX** – Anytime is a great time to visit the Texas State Auxiliary Museum in Lancaster, Texas. This museum is one of only two designated auxiliary museums in the state and offers an opportunity to learn more about the history of Texas, the City of Lancaster and the Texas Interurban Railway.

The museum itself is within the historic Interurban Building, built in 1911 as a station along the Texas Interurban Railway that ran from Waxahachie, through Lancaster, to Sherman-Denison until the 1950s. The museum is open to the public Monday through Friday from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. and Saturday from 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. Admission is free.
