

## definitions

### Part 1 Crime

The F.B.I. chooses these crimes on the basis of their seriousness, frequency of occurrence, pervasiveness in all areas of the country, and likelihood of being reported.

### Crime Definitions:

*Murder:* The willful (non-negligent) killing of one human being by another.

*Robbery:* The taking or attempting to take anything of value from the care, custody, or control of a person or persons by force or threat of force or violence and/or by putting the victim in fear.

*Aggravated Assault:* An unlawful attack by one person upon another for the purpose of inflicting severe or aggravated bodily injury. This type of assault usually is accompanied by the use of a weapon or by means likely to produce death or great bodily harm. Simple assaults are excluded.

*Burglary:* The unlawful entry of a structure to commit a felony or a theft. Attempted forcible entry is included.

*Theft:* The unlawful taking or stealing of property or articles without the use of force, violence or fraud.


*Motor Vehicle Theft:* The unlawful taking or stealing of a motor vehicle including attempts.

*Sexual Assault:* The carnal knowledge of a person through the use or threat of force. Assault to commit forcible sexual assault are also included.



## MADD awards


