WESTRIDGE AVENUE RECONSTRUCTION


Welcome to the City of Lancaster Westridge Avenue Reconstruction Project! Scheduled to begin on August 1, 2024, and expected to be completed by September 6, 2024 (weather permitting), this reconstruction spans from Pleasant Run Road to Griffin Street. It is part of the \$30 million Capital Improvement Road Reconstruction Program. These upgrades are essential for ensuring safer and more efficient transportation for all residents and visitors.

PROJECT SPECIFICS

The project involves reconstructing the current pavement with a 2-inch top layer of asphalt over a 3-inch middle layer of asphalt, and a 4-inch base layer of compacted material or a 6-inch layer of lime-treated soil. This phased construction will cover approximately 0.7 miles.

ADDITIONAL DETAILS

- The initial phase will be on the southbound lanes and will take approximately 2-3 weeks. Traffic will flow two-ways in the northbound lane, once complete we will switch traffic over to the south lane to repave the northbound lane.
- The entire scope of work at Westridge Ave. is estimated to take approximately 5-6 weeks. There will not be any complete street closure as the contractor will close one travel lane while working on the other travel lane until completion of work.
- Please travel slowly in the areas of ongoing construction, abide to all construction signage posted and flaggers, and be mindful of heavy machinery at work.
