**OMNIBUS ORDER ON INMATES RECEIVING TIME SERVED CREDIT FOR CONFINEMENT IN JAIL**

The Court finds that from time to time a defendant who is serving time in jail on fine-only misdemeanors originating out of the Lancaster Municipal Court and may enter a plea of guilty or no contest and substitute his/her time served in jail as payment for his/her outstanding fines and costs owing to the City of Lancaster.

The Judge of the Municipal Court finds that the interests of justice will be served by authorizing the Municipal Court for the City of Lancaster, Texas, to permit defendants to serve time in jail in lieu of payment of fines and costs owing by the defendant to the City of Lancaster, Texas.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED AND DECREED that upon application to the Presiding Judge of the Lancaster Municipal Court by a defendant serving time in jail, the Presiding Judge may from time to time enter an order permitting a defendant to apply his/her time served in jail to the fines and costs owing by a defendant at the rate of fifty dollars and no cents (\$50.00) per each twenty-four (24) hours served by the defendant.
