**Lancaster, TX** – The City of Lancaster will participate in the Ask Not - Dallas County Day of Service on Thursday, November 21, 2013 and on Saturday, November 23, 2013 to honor the life and legacy of President Kennedy and highlight the strength and diversity of Dallas County: a 21st century mosaic. During his inauguration speech on January 20, 1961, President John F. Kennedy challenged Americans to a higher level of concern and action for their neighbors in one of his most famous statements, "Ask not what your country can do for you, but what you can do for your country."

Throughout the month of November, the City of Lancaster will be collecting non-perishable food items and will be delivering the donations to the Lancaster Outreach Center on Thursday, November 21, 2013. All non-perishable food items are accepted, however food items such as: mac & cheese, Hamburger Helper, canned meat, pie filling, and granola bars, are needed most. Donation locations have been set at the Lancaster Public Safety Building (1650 N. Dallas Ave.), City Hall (211 N. Henry St.) or any of the Fire Stations.

Beltline Road) from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. We will be spreading seeds for seasonal plants, and painting the restroom facilities and pavilions.
